



Project under the incentive programme for the implementation of thermal renewable energy installations in different sectors of the economy, within the framework of the Recovery, Transformation and Resilience Plan, financed by the European Union - NextGenerationEU.

HOTEL MONTE IGUELDO S.L., continues with its commitment to the environment, promoting the use of renewable energies with the aim of reducing energy consumption, for which it has carried out the implementation of a renewable energy installation for air conditioning by means of aerothermal heat pumps.

The action has had a dual objective: thermal generation in a sustainable and efficient manner, as well as to reduce its dependence on conventional energy sources.

The action has been financed with the support of the European Union within the framework of the Recovery, Transformation and Resilience Plan, through the Next Generation EU Funds.

The project has been carried out in the Hotel Monte Igueldo building, located in San Sebastian (Guipuzcoa), and has involved the installation of climate control systems by renewable energy using heat pumps to cover the thermal demand for air-conditioning in 3 areas of the hotel.

The investment amounted to a total of 137,930.00 €, obtaining a subsidy of 54,756.00 €.
